

LUAS Meeting Minutes, January 2007

The January, 2007 meeting was called to order by President Michael Williams at 7:00 P. M., on Wednesday, January 10, 2007. Speakers Chuck Hixson and Dan Prikryl were introduced to an overflow crowd. At about 8:15 P. M. the business meeting commenced.

Ned Woodall announced the Llano County Historical Society would like a closer relationship with LUAS, and that the county museum still lacks a Native American exhibit. There may be money available to develop one. Ned requested that LUAS establish a committee to begin brainstorming ideas. Dan Prikryl offered to serve.

Next, officer elections were held. Doris Howard moved that all nominations be accepted and approved. The move was seconded and all officers were elected by acclamation.
